Plockton Public Library



Did you know that you can borrow all these items in the library?

Adult fiction, adult non-fiction, junior fiction, junior non-fiction, teenage books, reference materials, Gaelic books, titles of local interest, talking books, jigsaws, information leaflets; if we do not have what you are looking for – just ask!

Highland Libraries also stock collections of books in foreign languages (Polish, French, Spanish, Latvian, Russian). There are also resources available for those learning English

FREE Wi-Fi

Library members can access this service using their borrower number and PIN (available from staff).

Guests can obtain a temporary number and PIN from Library Staff.

BORROWING: ALL BOOKS ARE FREE TO

BORROW. An adult may borrow up to 20 items, a child up to 10 items. The library card is valid for use in any Highland Library.

Hire Charges: £1.00 for *adult audio books* (children's audio books are free). *DVDs* - £1.75 for a 2 week loan (junior Us are £1.00).

SERVICES: photocopying, faxing, People's Network Computers & Wi-Fi. There is a charge for photocopying.

REQUESTS: any item may be requested at a branch or on-line. If the item is adult non-fiction and is unavailable, we offer an Inter-Library Loan service for which the return postage is payable.

LOAN PERIOD: 3 weeks for books and audio books, 2 weeks for DVDs. Items can be renewed at any branch, by phone or on-line. Please quote your library number from your card or give your full name and address. On-line renewals will also require your PIN – available from library staff.

A LATE RETURN FEE OF 15P PER ITEM FOR BOOKS AND AUDIO BOOKS AND 50P PER DVD WILL BE CHARGED PER DAY THE LIBRARY IS OPEN. Children's materials and items on loan to Senior citizens are exempt.

PEOPLE'S NETWORK COMPUTERS are free to use. Sessions are for 1 hour or ½ hour and can be pre-booked. A charge of 20p per sheet is made for printing. Children under 8 years must be accompanied by an adult.

To use the computers you will need your borrower number and PIN. Visitors may obtain a guest ticket (on production of I.D.) which allows a ½ hour session only.
