PLOCKTON and DISTRICT COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEETING
14 DECEMBER 2020

1. Minutes of last meeting adopted by F Mackenzie and seconded by P Mackenzie.
2. Actions from previous meeting – Welcome to Plockton signs – IH and DM to action. Damaged road sign at bottom of Strathy – Biz Campbell to action. Railway Bridge poor signage, green strip and wrong size bumps – I Hay is liaising with Road Safety Officer who has agreed to look at it.
3. Letter to NTS relating to cattle and fencing in the village – Action on going.
4. Financial Report – Bank Accounts in process of being transferred over by previous CC members. Fireworks Account £2544.03, Special Projects Account £2648.03, Treasurers Account £1483.59(as per statement). £537.32 owed to CC members. Accounts have been audited and will be forwarded to Dot Ferguson. When submitted CC will receive the Highland Council Grant of £400.00
5. IT/PLOCKTON.ORG – On going review of IT situation.
6. PLANNING – no applications.
7. Kishorn Port Ltd – KPL have submitted two planning applications for changes to Kishorn Port and it's usage. The CC have reviewed the plans and the associated Marine Scotland Licence 07111 which restricts access to large areas of Outer Loch Carron and impacts the local fishermen. The CC have raised objections to the planning applications and written to Director Marine Scotland with concerns over the Marine Licence. Correspondence is available on Plockton.org. Chairman outlined the basis of the objections.
8. LICENSING – Application for variation to licence at Duncraig Castle – CC have raised no comments.
9. Covid 19 – The group is still active but not being used at present.
10. ROADS UPDATE - A constructive meeting was held recently with members from HC, PDCT and CC present to discuss roads and traffic management issues. White lines to be completed , Strathy to be resurfaced , damaged wall near CEANN AN UIB has been inspected, parking charges, 20mph signs for Duirinish, so some progress being made. I Hay is liaising with Mac Sutherland on these matters.
