Damaged road signs are on list to be done. Damaged Retaining wall near Duncraig footpath and Duirinish Bridge not high priority at the moment. Biz Campbell was asked about the reduction in the gritting budget and the fact that 2 gritters for our area broken down – she will bring up at Leaders meeting this week.
