

Outbreak of highly pathogenic avian influenza in poultry in Lochcarron

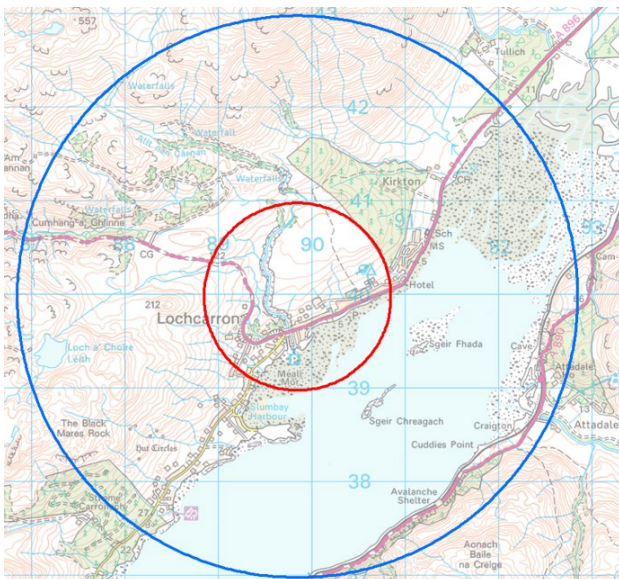
Do you live in Lochcarron and keep poultry or birds?

Important information – Please read and take action!

Highly pathogenic avian influenza (bird flu) was confirmed in poultry in Lochcarron on 09.08.2023 and new disease control zones & restrictions are in place.

There are actions you need to take if you live within 3km of an infected premises. Check the interactive map by visiting the website or scanning the QR code.
